WARNING: E-mail Impersonation Scam Targets Our Parishioners

In recent days, the Merciful Redeemer Parish has received reports from parishioners who have received suspicious emails supposedly from our priests. These emails attempt to start an online conversation or they have a suspicious document attached to the message. These emails are not from the Merciful Redeemer Parish. Online fraudsters are impersonating members of the parish staff and we ask you to be on the lookout for online scam attempts.

For this fraud effort, it is helpful to look carefully at the sender's information to determine whether an email is legitimate or not. The fraudster is unable to access the email accounts of our priests or staff, so they are using other email services to impersonate archdiocesan clergy and employees. For instance, the name in the "from" line will seem familiar, but the email address listed after the name will not be that person's usual account. Or the "from" line will list the familiar person's regular email address (instead of their name), but the email address listed after it will be another address entirely.

If the sender information seems odd or if the message is out of character for the sender, do not reply to the message or download any of its attachments. Please report the email to the parish office by calling us immediately. If we are vigilant with our online security, these fraud attempts should stop soon.
